

Summer Semester 2020: Announcement: Examinations at the Department of Economics

Registration and Withdrawal Periods for Examinations

Registration is to be effected for all module exams (except for *Academic Research and Writing*, *Topics* and those with term papers)

from **July 03, 2020 till July 09, 2020** for the **first exam period**
and from **August 28, 2020 till September 03, 2020** for the **second exam period**.

Withdrawal may be effected for all module exams (except for *Academic Research and Writing*, Research papers and *Topics*)

till **July 13, 2020** for the **first exam period**
and till **September 07, 2020** for the **second exam period**.

All students are obliged to check the relevant registration or withdrawal data immediately after having effected such and to notify the Economics Examination Office (*Wirtschaftswissenschaftlichen Prüfungsamt*) immediately of possible discrepancies (within the registration period). As proof of registration or withdrawal either the **confirmation e-mail** and/or the pdf-file „**Info über angemeldete Prüfung**“ (*Information about exam(s) registered*) have to be **saved** (either on your computer or as a print-out). All registrations and withdrawals as visible on www.basis.uni-bonn.de under „Info über angemeldete Prüfung“ are binding after the end of the registration period/after withdrawal is no longer possible.
