

Summer Semester 2021: Announcement: Examinations at the Department of Economics As of June 7, 2021

We will announce necessary changes as needed and in due time.

Registration and Withdrawal Periods for Exams

Registration is to be effected for all module exams (except for *Academic Research and Writing, Topics* and those with term papers)

from **July 05, 2021 till July 14, 2021** for the **first exam period**
and from **August 25, 2021 till September 02, 2021** for the **second exam period**.

All students are obliged to check the relevant registration or withdrawal data immediately after having effected such and to notify the Economics Examination Office (*Wirtschaftswissenschaftlichen Prüfungsamt*) immediately of possible discrepancies (within the registration period). As proof of registration or withdrawal either the **confirmation e-mail** and/or the pdf-file „**Info über angemeldete Prüfung**“ (*Information about exam(s) registered*) have to be **saved** (either on your computer or as a print-out). All registrations and withdrawals as visible on www.basis.uni-bonn.de under „Info über angemeldete Prüfung“ are binding after the end of the registration period/after withdrawal is no longer possible.

Deregistration is possible in SoSe 2021 for all final module exams **before submission of the written work** or until **immediately before the end of the oral examination**. Up to 1 day before the examination it can be effected regularly via BASIS, afterwards and in the event of technical difficulties, by email to vwlp@uni-bonn.de (mail from your @uni-bonn.de address, stating your matriculation number and the name of the module). Failure to hand in, failure to appear, or crossing an exam on the day of the exam will automatically result in withdrawal from the respective exam. **Therefore, please refrain from withdrawing due to illness.**

Students who hand in an exam and fail it will be given an additional retake attempt. This rule applies only once for each exam across semesters and does not apply to attempts at cheating.
