### Examinations at the Department of Economics

As of May 5, 2022

#### Registration and Withdrawal Periods for Exams

**Registration** is to be effected for all module exams (except for *Academic Research and Writing, Topics* and those with term papers)

from **June 27, 2022 till July 04, 2022** for the **first exam period**  
and from **August 29, 2022 till September 05, 2022** for the **second exam period**.

All students are obliged to check the relevant registration or withdrawal data immediately after having effected such and to notify the Economics Examination Office (*Wirtschaftswissenschaftlichen Prüfungsamt*) immediately of possible discrepancies (within the registration period). As proof of registration or withdrawal either the **confirmation e-mail** and/or the pdf-file „**Info über angemeldete Prüfung**“ (*Information about exam(s) registered*) have to be **saved** (either on your computer or as a print-out). All registrations and withdrawals as visible on [www.basis.uni-bonn.de](http://www.basis.uni-bonn.de) under „Info über angemeldete Prüfung“ are binding after the end of the registration period/after withdrawal is no longer possible.

**There will be no additional retake attempt (coronabedingter-Freiversuch).**

**\*\*\*NEW\*\*\* (as of May 03, 2022)**

The following regulations apply for **deregistration from examinations** in the **summer semester 2022**:

- **Examinations** of the first examination phase: July 8, 2022
- **Examinations** of the second examination phase: September 8, 2022
- **Final theses** that were registered **before** the new version of the Rectorate's decision came into force (by **May 03, 2022**): until the submission of the thesis
- **Final theses** registered **after** the new version of the Rectorate's decision came into force on **May 04, 2022**: the regulations of the examination regulations apply (return of the topic within the first two weeks after receiving it or withdrawal in case of illness)
- **Term papers**: until the submission of the paper
- Academic Research and Writing (**Wissenschaftliches Arbeiten**): until submission of the paper
- **Topics**: until submission of the paper

**Failure to submit exam results, non-appearance, or crossing out exam results on the day of the exam will result in a failed attempt.** Withdrawals due to illness are permitted and may be necessary within the limits of the examination regulations.

#### Duration of Module Examinations in the Bachelor and Master Program

According to BPO 2016 incl. amendments (*Examination Regulations in Volkswirtschaftslehre/Wirtschaftswissenschaften (Economics)*) the exam durations for the **Bachelor programs** are scheduled for **60 minutes** until further notice – with the following **exceptions**:

**Registrations for exams with the exam format term paper are to be effected from April 13, 2022 until April 20, 2022.**

**Registrations for exams Academic Research and Writing (Wissenschaftliches Arbeiten) (Bachelor) are to be effected from April 11, 2022 till April 18, 2022.**

There is no exam registration for Topics Modules.

Exams in Academic Research and Writing (*Wissenschaftliches Arbeiten*), and Topics are seminary exams during the semester.
